## Parking Lots

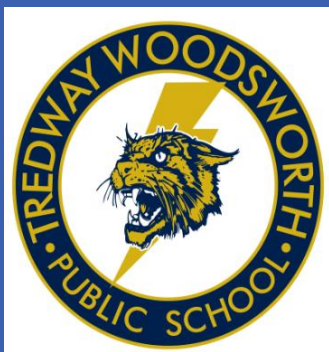
